INTRODUCTION

The Absentee Shawnee Tribe of Oklahoma hereby invites proposals from independent contractors for Concrete and Asphalt of New Parking Lots, Maintenance Repair of Entrance Roads and Striping of the Tribal Complex Facility. Maintenance and Repair is on an "as needed" basis. These services are required to preserve our Tribal Facility.

This Invitation for Bids (IFB) contains General Conditions, Specifications, General Information and Instructions to proposers, Bid Requirements and other pertinent information for submitting a proper and responsive bid. Prospective proposers desiring any explanation or interpretation of the solicitation must submit via email questions at least seven (7) calendar days before the IFB submittal deadline. The invitation must be addressed to Misty Griffith, Procurement Director, at the address stated below. Any information given to a prospective proposer about this solicitation will be furnished to all other prospective proposers as a written amendment to the solicitation.

Late submissions will not be accepted. Submissions received prior to the opening will be held in confidence until the opening. After evaluation of the responses, the Contract will be awarded to the proposer/s representing the "Best Value" to The Absentee Shawnee Tribe of Oklahoma. The resulting Contract may be funded through Tribal Transportation Program 23 U.S. Code 202.

GENERAL CONDITIONS

- 1.1 The Contractor shall provide concrete and asphalt of new parking lots, maintenance repair to entrance roads and striping of the complex facility as specified herein, on an "as needed" basis at various locations on the Tribal Complex.
- 1.2 Contractor **must** begin work within **five (5) days** after receipt of the Notice of Awarded Contract unless otherwise specified in the Contract.
- 1.3 **Regulatory**: Contractor(s) shall comply with all applicable federal, tribal, state and local laws, rules, regulations, ordinances and codes and obtain any licenses or permits required to provide the services under this IFB (if needed).
- 1.4 **Licensing**: Contractor shall be licensed as required by the jurisdiction in which the service is to be performed and the license shall be current and in good standing.
- 1.5 **Proposal Prices**: Proposers are advised that the Proposal Fee shall be all inclusive and fully burdened to accomplish the work as specified in this IFB and any resulting contract.
- 1.6 **Responsibility for Subcontractors**: All requirements for the "Prime" contractor shall also apply to any and all subcontractors. It is the Prime Contractors' responsibility to insure the compliance by the subcontractors. Regardless of subcontracting, the Prime Contractor remains liable to AST for the performance under this IFB or any resulting contract.
- 1.7 Contractor shall provide at contractor's own expense all equipment, labor, materials, supplies, and tools to perform all the services required under this IFB and any resulting contract.
- 1.8 Liquidated Damages: For each day that performance under a resulting contract from this IFB is delayed beyond the time specified for completion, the Contractor shall be liable for liquidated damages in the amount of \$100.00 per day. However, the timeframe for performance may be adjusted at AST's discretion in writing and received by the successful proposer prior to default under any resulting contract.
- 1.9 If any employee of the Contractor is deemed unacceptable by AST, "Prime" Contractor shall immediately replace such personnel with a substitute acceptable to AST.
- 1.10 **BONDING:** All Surety Bonds shall be issued by companies licensed to do business in the State of Oklahoma, Payment & Performance Bonds shall be provided to AST prior to commencing work on any single project that exceeds \$50,000.00. Bid Bond, Performance Bond and Payment Bond.

- 3.2 **Mandatory Pre-Bid Meeting**: A site visit is required if the project is such that the Proposal shall have actual knowledge of the physical situation relative to the IFB Closing date in order to submit a valid bid. **May 28**th, **2019 at 9:30AM** beginning location will be the Procurement Department.
- 3.3 **Submission Deadline and Location:** The IFB and all attachments are to be included within the required proposal submissions which include one (1) original signature copy marked "Original" along with three (3) photocopies of your proposal marked "Copy 1" through "Copy 3". The original proposal, all attachments and all required copies may be bundled in one sealed package. Facsimile and/or Email proposals shall NOT be accepted. All Proposals shall be submitted and received by the Absentee Shawnee Tribe of Oklahoma in the Procurement Department **NO LATER THAN 4:00PM, Friday, June 4th, 2019**

- 3.4 **Bid Opening Results:** It is understood by all proposers that the proposals are publicly opened and read out loud with the bidder name and price. The results will be a matter of public record. The location of the Bid openings will be held **Wednesday**, **June 5th**, **2019 at 9:00AM** at the Procurement Conference Room located in the Procurement Department, Building 18C on the Absentee Tribal Complex.
- 3.5 **Notice of Award:** The Awarded proposer will receive a Notice of Award presented by the Absentee Shawnee Tribe of Oklahoma by **Wednesday, June 5th, 2019** via email.
 - Upon receipt of Notice of Award, The Absentee Shawnee Tribe of Oklahoma must not provide additional plans or specs to the Prime contractor and/or subcontractors unless prior arrangements have been made in writing.
- 3.6 **Davis-Bacon Wage Act:** This project is subject to Federal prevailing wage requirements. Prime Contractor and Subcontractors must pay all trades in their employ Federal prevailing wage determination. In addition to the Davis-Bacon Wage Act, all Contractors and Subcontractors on the project will be required to submit one (1) set of certified payroll <u>each week.</u> Submission must be turned into the Procurement Department, attention to Misty Griffith, Procurement Director.


